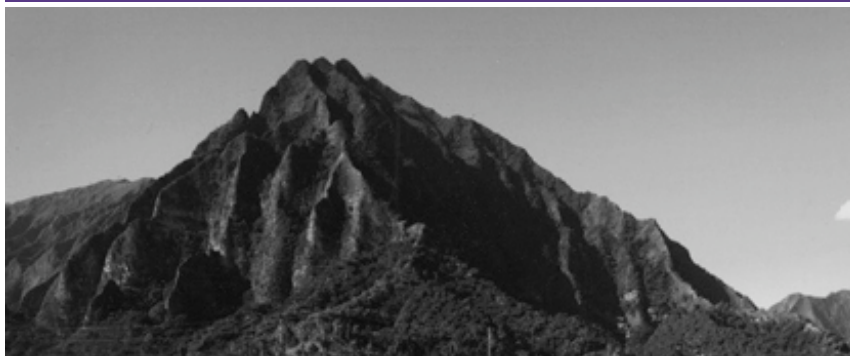

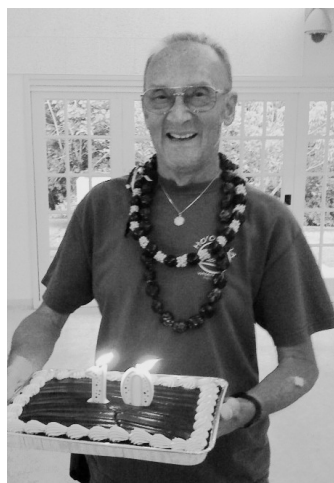
Marlene - Has Left the Building!
